Thank you for your interest in Camp Abnaki. Please take a moment to read the scholarship application completely to assure we have all the information we need to process your request. Incomplete applications will be returned to you, which will delay processing of your application or make you ineligible if The session you requested is full. A complete application *must* include:

- A completed Camp Abnaki registration form
- Registration deposit (\$150 for resident camp, \$25 for day camp)
- Copy of your Federal Tax Return for 2014 (form 1040)
- Two most recent paystubs and/or verification of federal or state Assistance received (SSI, SRS, ANFC, General Assistance, Food Stamps, Reach Up, etc.)
- Copy of the Financial Assistance application

Please note that Camp Abnaki is not eligible to receive State of Vermont childcare subsidy.

There is a high demand for financial assistance and we try to serve as many families as possible. For this reason, we do not fund 100% of anyone's total camp tuition. The amount of campership awarded is based upon availability of funds, family income, family size, session availability, and family need. **When returning a completed scholarship application, a registration deposit is required to reserve a space. You will not receive a confirmation packet or have a space reserved without this deposit.**

**Should you decline our scholarship offer, your deposit will be refunded to you.**

*If we have a completed application in, we will notify you of any campership award you have received by April 4, 2015. We are unable to apply the Sibling Discount or the Y Member Discount to any applications for financial assistance.*
