## Paying for Child Care

### Vermont State Subsidies

Vermont state child care subsidies are available to eligible families, according to a Vermont law (Act 76). Families can use these funds to reduce or eliminate the cost of care. State subsidy dollars are only available for use at licensed programs, including the Y early childhood care, Y afterschool programs, and Camp Koda.

On the back of this page, you will see a table that sets forth family household income eligibility for subsidy and an estimate of the discounted rate you may pay for Y programs.

### YMCA Scholarships

Thanks to the generous support of donors, the Greater Burlington YMCA provides financial assistance for families that cannot afford the full cost of a Y program, including early childhood care, afterschool, and camp programs.

To best align the state subsidy process with our Y financial assistance, we require anyone applying for Y support to demonstrate that they have first applied for the Vermont child care subsidy. However, receipt of Y financial assistance is not contingent upon a family qualifying for state subsidy.

We ask that those who receive Y scholarships pay a percentage of the program cost and to recognize that financial assistance funds are limited. To apply for Y financial assistance, go to: [gbymca.org/membership/financial-assistance/](https://gbymca.org/membership/financial-assistance/).
